Day 4 - Section 12: 3am early rise Mount Sonder Climb (16km, grade 5)

Day 5 - Section 9/10: Ormiston Pound walk to Mount Giles, to Alice Springs (9km, grade 3)



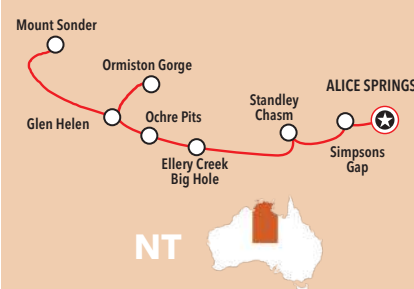

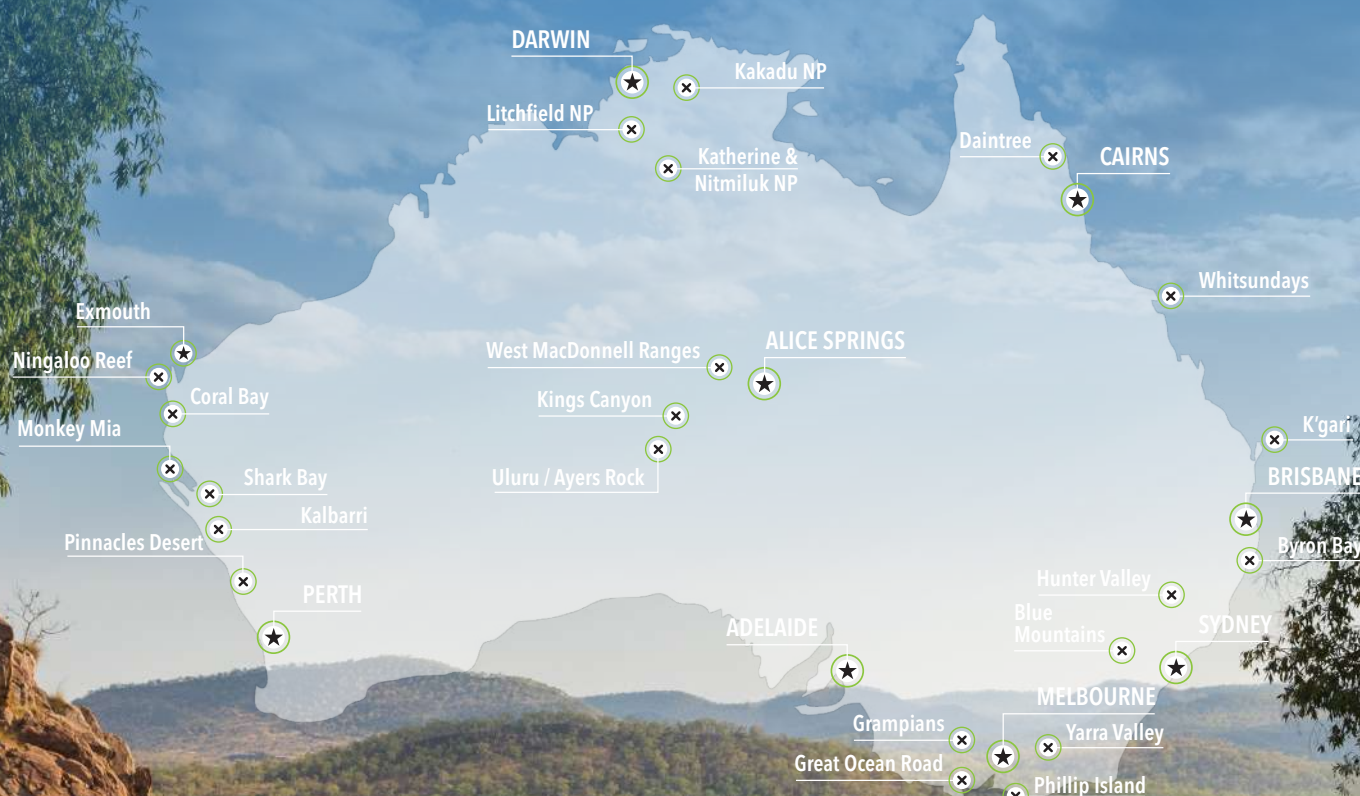
