# 1 DAY LITCHFIELD NATIONAL PARK & WATERFALLS

Let us take you to one of our favourite places on earth, Litchfield National Park. Departing Darwin, we head towards this natural paradise, surrounded by scenic bushland and cascading waterfalls, offering a cool escape from the Top End heat.

Along the way, you can choose to hop on the famous Jumping Crocodile Cruise (optional extra) on the Adelaide River, or visit the Fogg Dam Conservation Reserve, a haven for Australian wildlife.

The Limilngan-Wulna people manage the reserve, and it's home to an array of birds, turtles, water pythons, and iconic crocodiles.

We'll discover the awe-inspiring Magnetic Termite Mounds before cooling off in Litchfield's refreshing plunge pools, like Buley Rockholes or Florence Falls. You'll also have the opportunity to marvel at the stunning Wangi Falls, cascading gracefully over a rocky escarpment. After a day immersed in natural beauty, we return to Darwin, feeling relaxed and rejuvenated.

# 1 DAY KAKADU NATIONAL PARK & WILDLIFE

Experience the heart of the Top End as we explore Kakadu National Park. Departing from Darwin, we journey through vibrant landscapes into Kakadu, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its ancient Aboriginal rock art, abundant wildlife, and dramatic terrain spanning over 20,000 square kilometers.

You'll have the option of a Crocodile Cruise on the Adelaide River to get up close with saltwater crocodiles or visit the Fogg Dam Conservation Centre, a wildlife haven home to various species, including birds, turtles, and water pythons.

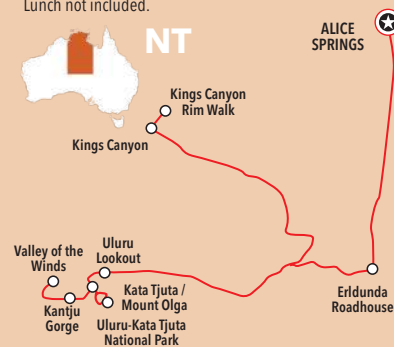

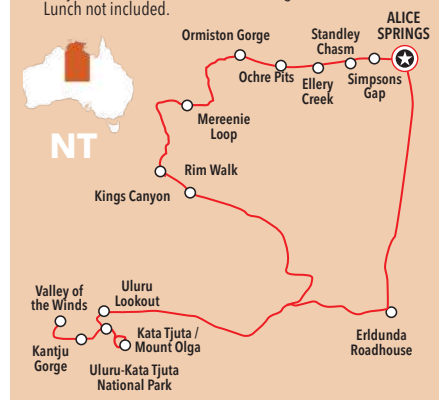
