Pinnacles Desert, Nambung National Park

1 DAY PINNACLES DESERT LOBSTER & YANCHEP

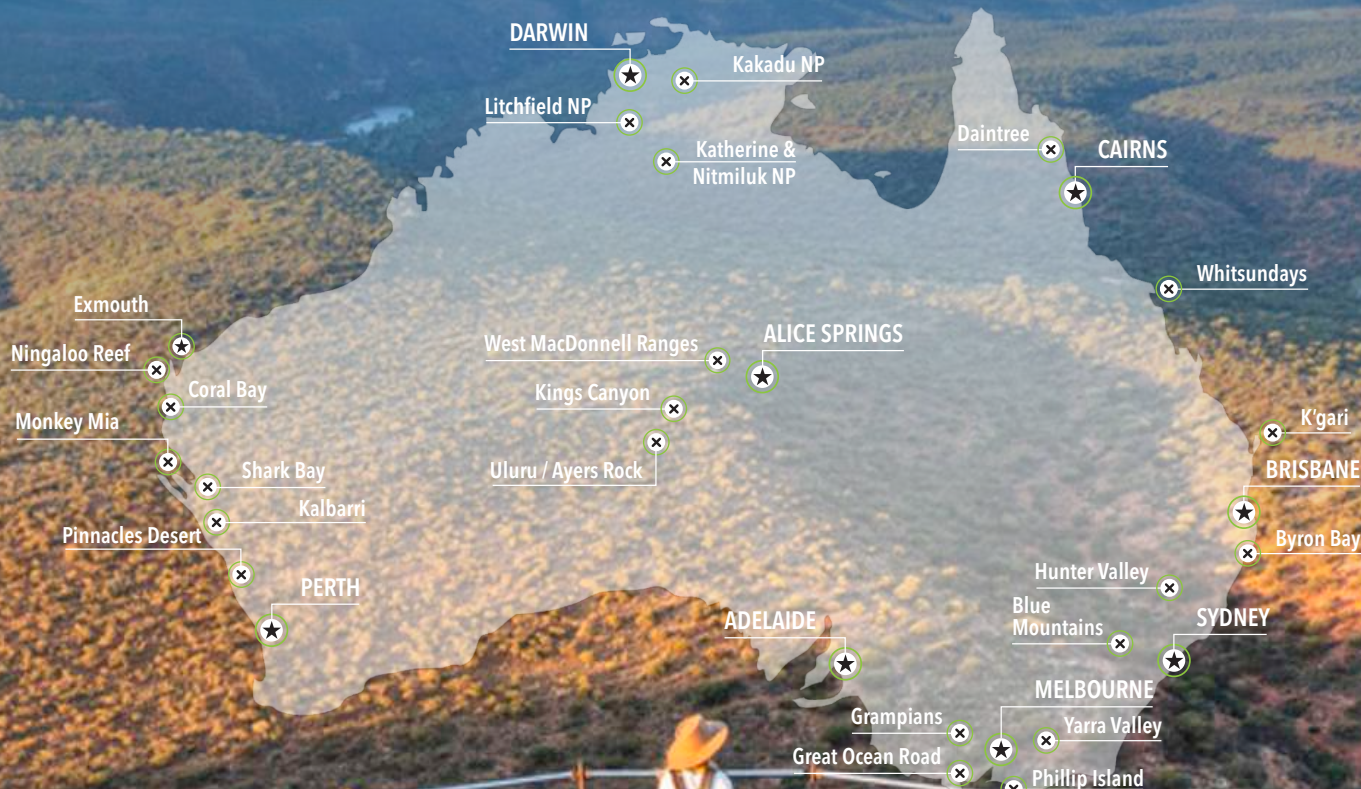
